Hawaii Softball Foundation Scholarship Fund 2014 – 2015 Academic Year

Dear Applicant:

In 2010, the Hawaii Softball Foundation established a scholarship fund to help softball student athletes continue their education after graduating from high school. Five \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded for the 2014-2015 academic year:

- Family Stones Softball Club Scholarship: The scholarship, donated by the Family Stones Softball Club, will be awarded, with preference, to the winning school of the Annual Family Stones Alumni Tournament. This year's recipient will be a student athlete from Kamehameha Schools.
- SportStan Outer Island Scholarship: The scholarship, donated by SportStan, will be awarded with preference, to an outer island student athlete.
- Oahu Junior Olympics and the Hawaii Softball Foundation will contribute to donate the remaining three scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a member of her high school softball team.
- Applicant, at the time the scholarship is awarded, be accepted to a university, college, community college, vocational or trade school, or pursue other post-high school study.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

You must enroll on a fulltime basis in the fall semester in the same type of school you indicated on the application form. If these conditions are not met, your award will be withdrawn.

Furthermore, should you subsequently receive a full scholarship that includes all room/board expenses, or you receive a full tuition scholarship and reside at home, then you will become ineligible to receive the scholarship award.

INSTRUCTIONS AND CRITERIA:

The following criteria and maximum points for each criterion will be used in making final selections for scholarships. Total maximum points is 100. Applicants will be ranked for scholarships by numerical composite score.

1. Scholarship Fund Application

- Complete the application form and sign
- · You must submit signed hard copy application and related forms

2. Financial Need (30 points)

- Complete the Financial Statement
 - > You must provide complete information
 - > If a space is left blank or indicated "not applicable," you must explain why
 - > You may attach a narrative to further explain your financial condition

3. Academic Achievement (40 points)

- Official high school transcript should be mailed directly to Hawaii Softball Foundation
 - > Copies will not be accepted
 - > If not available, include a transcript from your most recent year

4. Personal Letter (20 points)

- Compose a personal letter including:
 - > Why you are seeking the scholarship
 - > What are you career goals
 - > What extracurricular activities you have been involved in and why
 - > List any achievements

5. Recommendations (10 points) (form attached)

- Submit a minimum of two recommendations on the forms provided
- Current or past coaches, employers, teachers may write recommendations
- Must be mailed directly to Hawaii Softball Foundation by the deadline date
- Letters of recommendations are welcomed, but the minimum of two recommendation forms are still required

6. Photo

- Submit a headshot photo (preferably a high resolution JPEG or TIF digital file)

- Photos will not be returned and only used if the applicant is selected

7. Mail Application

• Application materials, including all forms, transcripts, recommendations, and photo must be received or postmarked by May 1, 2015.
