Venue Directions: The Les Murakami Stadium is located on lower campus. EMS personnel are to be directed to enter form the Dole St. entrance.

When coming from King St. Go North on University turn right at the corner of University Avenue and Dole St. across from Bachman Hall. Turn right at the first stop light after the intersection. This will lead you to Lower Campus Road. Drive through the guard booth and proceed towards the Stan Sheriff Arena. Drive past the Stan Sheriff Arena and follow the road, turn L into the third base line parking lot and into the Stadium.

When coming from King St. Go North on University turn right at the corner of University Avenue and Dole St. across from Bachman Hall. Turn right at the first stop light after the intersection. This will lead you to Lower Campus Road. Drive through the guard booth and proceed towards the Stan Sheriff Arena. Drive past the Stan Sheriff Arena and follow the road until stop sign behind right field of the Les Murakami Baseball Stadium. Immediately turn left after passing the baseball stadium. Follow this road, there will be a set of grass fields on the right. Once passing the grass fields, there will be a gravel driveway. Proceed down this driveway and drive to the appropriate venue. This will lead to the tennis courts.
