Aloha Section PGA Foundation Scholarship Program

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Aloha Section PGA Foundation Scholarship Program is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher educational goals for Hawaii high school seniors and current college students who have actively participated in the game of golf and have excelled in their academic achievements.

II. SCHOLARSHIPS

The Aloha Section PGA Foundation Scholarship is designed to award one-year educational scholarships. The amount of the scholarships will be a maximum of **\$5,000**. Determination of award winners will be made by the Aloha Section PGA Scholarship Committee.

III. SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the following competitive basis by using a combination of criteria, depending on class level:

- Academic Performance: includes high school/college grades, class rank, GPA and/or ACT/SAT test scores
- Financial Need
- Extracurricular Activities
- Personal References

Extracurricular activities will help the Committee further evaluate the candidate's interest and abilities. Contributions to the community may be demonstrated by involvement in local clubs, organizations and associations. Extracurricular activities should be documented by type and years of service.

* Special consideration will be given to applicants who are *high school seniors* with a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 grading scale. Current college students are encouraged to apply.

IV. ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

Successful applicants will be mailed an announcement by the end of April. **All recipient(s) will be REQUIRED to attend the Aloha Section PGA Classic Scramble on Monday, May 18, 2015.**

Aloha Section PGA Foundation Scholarship Application Guidelines

1. Applications must be returned to the Aloha Section PGA by **5:00 PM on WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15, 2015 (receipt date, not postmark date)**. Typed applications are preferred. **Faxed applications will not be accepted.**

3. Applicants **MUST** be high school seniors who have completed (or plan to complete) high school prior to August 1, 2015 and enroll (or plan to enroll) in an accredited college or university in the Fall of 2015. The institution must be located in the United States.
4. Applicants **MUST** be a Hawaii resident and have an involvement with the game of golf.
5. The enclosed reference form should be completed by your high school principal, guidance counselor, or a person who is knowledgeable of your:
 - High school experience
 - History of active participation in golf
 - Potential for successful college level study
 - Need for financial assistance for college expenses
6. Along with each application, the applicant must:
 - ✓ Sign and date application
 - ✓ Include a copy of his/her most recent high school transcripts
 - ✓ Include a copy of his/her ACT/SAT test scores
 - ✓ Contain the one page essay described on page 2 of the application form
 - ✓ Include one head shot photo of applicant (at least 4x6) from the shoulders up
 - ✓ Include 2 personal reference forms
