The back gates behind the first tennis courts and baseball fields have had new locks put on them and we do not have access to those gates. However, the parks keepers have let us know that the locks will be unlocked for us this week. Please bring your canoes early enough or the day before if needed to help alleviate any confusions or congestions. (\*\*\*Please check the lock before driving into the tennis court back entrance in case the park keeper does not open it. If there are any questions, I will be on site from Friday morning around the Official Stand or please find a park worker to assist you with the gate.)
