Currently, there are three (3) non-wood baseball bats that the NFHS has decertified for use in high school competition. <u>This short list is subject to change</u>. <u>Additional non-wood baseball bats</u> <u>could possibly be added to this list</u>. The decertified bats are the following:

Marucci Cat 5² 33" non-wood baseball bat (Decertification notice date: February 21, 2012)

Reebok Vector TLS 32" non-wood baseball bat (Decertification notice date: March 26, 2012)

Reebok Vector TLS 33" non-wood baseball bat (Decertification notice date: March 26, 2012)
